Categories

Blanket Trader blanket traders may sell 18th century trade goods from a blanket or skin laid on the ground. Display space size is that of a 4 point blanket (72" x90") 45 square feet. All goods sold must be approved by the Committee Staff.

Merchant Merchants may sell 18th century trade goods from a shelter. Shelters must meet period specifications. All goods sold must be approved by the committee Staff.

Traditional Craftsman Traditional craftsman must demonstrate a craft of the 18th century and produce an 18th century replica, using tools and equipment of the time period and must be onsite during hours of operation. Traditional craftsmen may sell their hand-made goods.

Participant / Program Personnel Individuals or groups in this group are primarily interpreters of some aspect of 18th century life. These include musicians, militia, military etc.
